Background

Agriculture remains a critical component of India's economy. Women in India play a predominate role in agriculture, food provisioning and subsistence agricultural activities. The share of agriculture to India's GDP is 16%. The contribution of Livestock and Poultry to India's GDP is 4.11%. Similarly Indian fisheries and aquaculture is also an important sector of food production, providing nutritional security and engaging about fourteen million people in different activities and contributing 1.1% of the GDP. Keeping the role of animal protein in human diet with rising income, population growth and urbanization, the demand for livestock, poultry and fish based products is expanding rapidly in India. The livestock, poultry and fishery sector plays a vital role for livelihood improvement of rural people and women play an important role in it. Women's participation is vital to food security and family well being and their need for labour saving and income generating technologies are acute. The expanding market for these products also offers an opportunity for augmenting their income of those who do not have access to land and capital resources. Ensuring quality participation and empowerment of women in livestock, poultry and fisheries production is need of the hour for sustainable development in food production for poverty alleviation, food security and promotion of gender equality. While at global level, there has been a lot of concern and action on empowerment of women in agriculture, efforts in India has been slow on this front. In this context, a Model Training Course entitled "**Livelihood Security of Farmwomen through Dairy, Poultry and Fish Production**" has been planned for the state agricultural officers, extension dept. officers and scientists of ICAR/SAUs/KVKs at ICAR-CIWA, Bhubaneswar.

Objectives

- To orient the participants on gender issues in agriculture, especially on livestock, poultry and fisheries sector
- To improve the professional competence and upgrade the knowledge of participants in livestock, poultry and fisheries development
- To enable them understand and integrate gender perspective in their research and extension project
- To provide an opportunity of sharing experience and exchange ideas/ knowledge amongst the participants and experts

Faculty and Training Methodology

The Model Training Course would comprise of lectures from well qualified and experienced scientists from ICAR-CIWA and guest lecturers from experienced scientists/faculty from ICAR, Agricultural Universities and other reputed organizations. Additionally, group exercises, interactive sessions and field visits will also form part of the programme.

Venue & Duration

The Model Training Course will be organized at ICAR-CIWA, Bhubaneswar. The Course will be of 8 days duration from **1-8 November 2018**.

Eligibility

Participants exclusively from State Development Departments concerned, ICAR/SAUs/KVKs/Others. The total number of participants shall be limited to 20.

How to Apply

Nomination for the training should be sent through proper channel in the prescribed format. The nominations should reach this office latest by 1st October, 2018. The applications received would be scrutinized and will be intimated to the participants.

Travel, Boarding & Lodging

The travel expenses of the participants will be reimbursed as per entitlement (AC II/ III in Train and Bus or other means) on production of certificate & tickets. Participants will also be provided free boarding and lodging as per the norms/guidelines of ICAR. The participants will be accommodated in ICAR-CIWA trainees' hostel located in Campus of Indian Institute of Water Management (formerly known as DWM), in front of Rail Vihar, Chandrasekharpur, Bhubaneswar.

About ICAR-CIWA

The ICAR-Central Institute for Women in Agriculture (formerly Directorate of Research on Women in Agriculture) has an exclusive mandate of undertaking strategic and applied research to identify gender issues, test agricultural technologies/programmes/policies with a women's perspective and undertake capacity building of stakeholders for inclusive agriculture.
