Monthly Report (July, 2017)

As part of the ongoing 'National Sanitation Campaign', weekly on-campus cleanliness drives were organized at ICAR-Central Institute for Women in Agriculture (ICAR-CIWA), Bhubaneswar during 1, 15, 22 and 29 July, 2017.

On 1st July 2017, a demonstration on waste bio-decomposition using microbes was organized in association with National Centre of Organic Farming (NCOF). The resource persons from NCOF demonstrated the method of decomposing agricultural wastes into compost using microbes, jaggery and water. About 5 quintals of agricultural wastes and kitchen wastes were put into composting for being used in CIWA farms.



The cleaning and sanitation activities were also carried out in the land area/ plot earmarked for each Staff in CIWA premises, and also in common areas. In the cleanliness drives in the common areas, farms and approach roads, along with the regular staff, the contractual farm staff also took part actively.
