16th-19th October, 2016

As part of the ongoing 'National Sanitation Campaign', 'Swachhta Pakhwada' is being observed during 16-31 October, 2016 at ICAR-CIWA, Bhubaneswar. On 17th October, at 10:30 AM, swachhta pledge was taken by all the staff. On 17th afternoon, an elocution competition was held on the theme, "Swachh Bharat-Swasth Bharat", in which 10 staff participated.

Mass cleanliness drives were also organized around the farm lands of the Institute, in which all the staff and the farm labourers actively took part and cleaned the weeds and debris around the farms and farm roads. Further, the total farm areas and the Institute premises have been earmarked for each staff in CIWA premises and cleaning and sanitation activities are carried out in their respective plots, daily for one hour during the Swachhta Pakhwada period.
