Report on the Campaign on Swachhta Pakhwada on 29 December, 2020

As part of the 'Swachhta Pakhwada' campaign being observed during 16th-31 December, 2020, a visit was made to community waste disposal sites/ compost pits, working in Bhubaneswar municipality area was made by the staff of ICAR-Central Institute for Women in Agriculture (ICAR-CIWA), Bhubaneswar. Awareness was created on treatment and safe disposal of bio-degradable as well as non-bio-degradable wastes by involving civil community, slum dwellers, vegetable vendors and school children. To utilise the biodegradable waste into agriculture a demonstration on vermicomposting was also made. The benefits of vermicomposting as well as organic farming was explained to the attendees. For proper disposal of non-degradable waste importance of recycling was emphasised. Minimising the use of plastic bags in daily life was emphasised and segregation of waste into degradable and non-degradable was demonstrated. The programme was led by Dr P.Jakhhar.
